SUBJ: Air Carrier Operations – During State of Emergency

To: FAA Administrator Steve Dickson

To relieve transport requirements associated with the Coronavirus COVID-19 Pandemic, it is hereby requested that EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY all piston and turbo-prop aircraft, having a:

- a) maximum passenger-seating configuration of six seats, a
- b) maximum payload capacity of 2,000 pounds, is
- c) qualified under CFR § 91.409 (b) *Aircraft Annual and 100 hour inspection complied with*, and is
- d) operated by a current and properly rated Commercial Pilot meeting the *Recent Flight Experience requirements* of CFR § 61.57 in that make and model of aircraft...

...be relieved of prohibitive regulations and be authorized to provide On-Demand and Commuter services carrying persons and property for hire.
