1) Registration:

Includes: FAA IACRA assistance, TSA documentation requirements, course registration review

2) FAA Knowledge Exam:

Includes: Q&A, instructor recommendation, third-party testing fee (a voucher is provided for scheduling at your convenience)

3) Training Material (includes sale tax)

Included: Online Ground School (self study course) and preparation for written exam, Electronic Flight Computer, FAA Aviation Weather Text Book, FAA Airplane Flying Handbook, Private Pilot Maneuvers Guide, Pilot's Handbook of Aeronautical Knowledge, Pilot's Log Book, FAR/AIM, Flight Gear Bag, Sectional Plotter, VFR/IFR Flight Plan Forms, VFR Sectional Chart, tax, shipping and handling.

Phase 1 Training

4) 15 hours of In-Flight training

Includes: Aircraft, fuel/oil, headset rental

5) 15 hours of flight training

6) 7 hour Ground Instruction (pre and post flight ground training)

7) Applicable sales tax

Phase 2 Training

8) 25 hours of In-Flight training

Includes: Aircraft, fuel/oil, headset rental

9) 10 hours of flight training

10) 10 hour Ground Instruction (pre and post flight ground training)

11) Final Phase Check (simulated practical check-ride)

(Aircraft, fuel/oil, headset rental, and CFI)

12) Applicable sales tax

13) When FAA Airmen Certification Standards for this certification are met, any remaining account balance may be applied toward the certification check-ride (e.g. Examiner fee, use of aircraft, etc)

**Phase 1 and 2 are based on FAA minimum requirement.*

According to the FAA the average time required varies between 60-75 hours of flight time.

***This does not include the Check-ride*
